

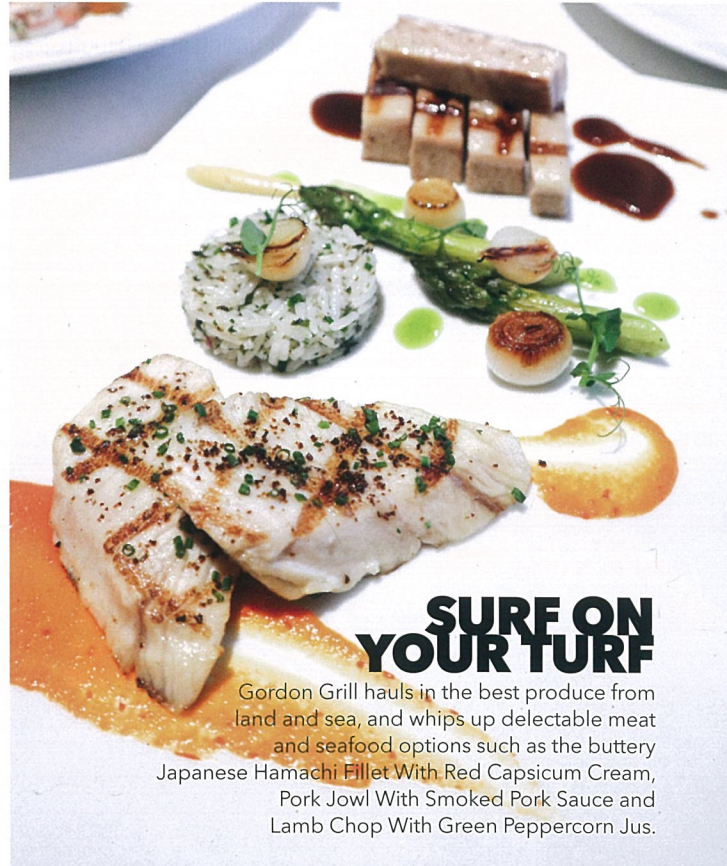
**Create Your Code**
